Summary

The Children's Minister is to create a safe, fun, and loving environment where children can become aware of God's love and accept Jesus Christ as his/her personal Savior. The minister will encourage the spiritual growth of children (birth – 5th grade) and equip parents to develop a biblical worldview within their family.

Qualifications

- 1. Clear testimony of faith in Jesus Christ and a vital, growing personal relationship with Him.
- 2. A lifestyle congruent with the biblical requirements for leaders. (1 Tim. 3:1-7)
- 3. Understanding of and willingness to affirm and serve within the doctrinal commitments of the church and its mission.
- 4. A minimum of 2 years of experience in a leadership position within a children's ministry of a Baptist church.
- 5. Creative, hard-working, passionate, energetic, and resourceful team player.
- 6. Experience recruiting, motivating, equipping and scheduling volunteers.
- 7. Called by God specifically to serve in children's ministries.
- 8. Able to develop worship experiences and other programs, which will capture the interest of children of various ages and backgrounds.
- 9. Aware of the resources available to develop a broad ministry to children.
- 10. A strong leader who is able to provide vision and direction to all who serve in the children's ministry.

Responsibilities

- 1. Plan, promote, and lead in all activities directed toward evangelism and discipleship of children (birth 5th grade).
- 2. Be involved in the teaching ministry for children (birth 5th grade). The extent of involvement will be determined by agreement between the Children's Minister and Pastor.
- 3. Maintain the integrity of the children's Bible teaching and curriculum by ensuring the instruction is consistent with the doctrinal conviction of the church.
- 4. In consultation with the Pastor and other church leaders, develop and continually evaluate a strategic plan for the children's ministry that contributes to the attainment of the church's mission and vision.
- 5. Lead the planning and execution of special projects (such as camps and retreats) for the children's ministry.
- 6. Prepare an annual children's ministry budget for approval to the Finance Ministry Team and administer the approved budget in association with the Children's Ministry Team.
- 7. Develop plans for discovering, recruiting, and training all children's workers. This includes continuing training for experienced workers as well as that for new workers.
- 8. Provide Pastoral Care such as salvation counseling, baptism follow-up, and support for children and their families in times
- 9. Equip parents to be involved in the spiritual formation of their children.
- 10. Evaluate the effectiveness of all Children's Ministries programs. Suggest needed changes and develop plans for making these changes.
- 11. Perform other ministry related duties as assigned by the Pastor.
